



1. Introduction

At BlindSpot Solutions, your privacy matters to us. We're committed to handling your personal information with care, transparency, and respect. 3. Information I collect

Personal Data you give us directly:

- Name, email address, phone number, and job title
- Postal or business address
- Any other information you choose to share in an enquiry, registration, or service engagement
 Information collected automatically (Usage Data):
- Your IP address
- Browser type and version
- Pages you visit and how long you spend on them
- Device identifiers and diagnostic information

Information from service delivery:

- Photos, video, or audio recordings taken with your consent during events, workshops, or onsite reviews
- Notes from meetings, consultations, or accessibility assessments

We only collect the information we need to deliver our services effectively, meet legal obligations, and improve the way we work.

4. How we use your information

We use your information to:

- 1. Provide our services Deliver the consulting, training, or resources you've requested
- 2. Communicate with you Respond to enquiries, send updates, and arrange services
- 3. Improve our services Analyse how people use our website and resources so we can make them better

- 4. Meet legal obligations Comply with Australian laws and protect our legal rights
- 5. Send marketing updates Share relevant news, resources, or offers if you've opted in (you can unsubscribe at any time)

We do not sell your personal information to third parties.

5. How we store and protect your information

We store your information securely in electronic form. Where we use third-party providers (such as Microsoft 365, Zoom, or Wix), your data may be stored in Australia or overseas.

We take reasonable steps to protect your personal information from loss, misuse, unauthorised access, disclosure, or alteration. While we use appropriate safeguards, no method of electronic storage or transmission is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

6. How we share your information

We may share your information in the following situations:

With service providers

To help deliver or improve our services (for example, cloud hosting, email platforms, or payment processing)

If required by law

When we must disclose information under Australian law or to comply with a legal process

With your consent

For specific purposes you agree to in writing

During business changes

If BlindSpot Solutions merges with another business or is sold, your information may be transferred as part of that process

We will never sell your personal information to third parties.
